This allows us to better tailor communication and information provision to the needs of visitors to our website. We cannot see who visits our websites or from which PC the visit takes place.
- Non-anonymous Analytical cookies: to gain insight into visits to our website based on information about visitor numbers, popular pages and topics. This allows us to better tailor communication and information provision to the needs of visitors to our website.
- Tracking cookies: such as advertising cookies designed to show relevant ads. Personal interests can be derived from information about visited websites. This allows organizations to show their website visitors targeted ads, for example. Tracking cookies make it possible to build profiles of people and treat them differently. Tracking cookies typically process personal data.
